Publication of Disciplinary Decisions Policy



Purpose

This policy provides information on how the CMC publicises the regulatory decisions of the Conduct and Discipline Committee (CDC).

Why are decision published?

CMC is committed to transparency and openness about our disciplinary processes which is also good practice amongst professional regulators. The overarching aim in publishing CDC outcomes is to protect the public by: -

- informing the public and mediators about the standards expected of CMC mediators and upholding standards.
- maintaining the public and the profession's trust in CMC as a regulator.

Where and how decisions published?

In line with the table at Annex A, decisions are published: -

- on the CMC website www.civilmediation.org and
- marked on the CMC register.
